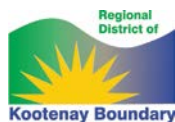

### BEAVER VALLEY YOUTH CLUB

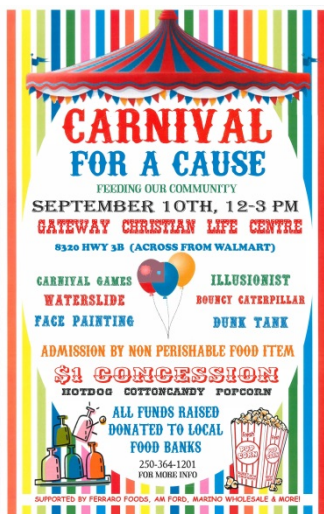

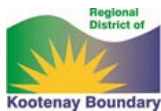

### **PROPERTY TAXES**

The Village of Fruitvale's 2017 Tax Sale will be held at 10:00am sharp on Monday, September 25, 2017 at the Village Office.

Letters have been sent to those property owners in a tax sale situation. If your property taxes are in delinquent status (three years of unpaid taxes 2015-2016-2017, you **must** pay the delinquent (2015) taxes **before** September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in order to keep your property from tax sale. Payment of delinquent taxes **must** be made by cash, certified cheque, or bank transfer of funds; **regular cheques or credit cards are not accepted for payment of delinquent taxes.**

### **RV PARK**

Creekside RV Park is now open! The park has 5 full service RV spaces, a walking path down to Beaver Creek with memorial benches along the path (to be installed) and a free sani-dump. We are still waiting for a couple of items to arrive to put the final touches in the park, but it is open to the public. Cost is \$25.00 per night; registration is at the Village Office. A grand opening is in the works, so stay tuned for more information.
