### **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Cecchini called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

### **PURPOSE OF THE MEETING**

The Mayor stated the purpose of the Public Hearing was to afford any persons who believe that their interest in property affected by matters contained in proposed "Village of Fruitvale Zoning Bylaw 846, 2013 Amendment Bylaw 869, 2016" an opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions respecting those matters.

She stated the process for those wishing to provide commentary was to provide their name and civic address within the Village of Fruitvale and be recognized by the Presiding Member of Council prior to speaking.

She noted the amendments are set out in "Village of Fruitvale Zoning Bylaw 846, 2013 Amendment Bylaw 869, 2016" which received two readings on March 7, 2016 and that public notification was provided by newspaper advertisement on March 9 and 16, 2016.

Mayor Cecchini stated that no further public submissions will be received for consideration by Council after the close of this Public Hearing.

The Mayor then invited the public to make presentations regarding the Bylaws. She further noted that: Council will not debate or enter discussion; the hearing is to receive comments only prior to the next reading of the Bylaws; and that Council will deliberate at the next Council meeting after receipt of the minutes of the Public Hearing, and may make amendments as deemed appropriate, give third reading and final adoption to the bylaw subsequently, or cancel entirely, at Council's discretion.

### **PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS**

Bylaw 869 - Addition of new Village Centre Downtown Residential Housing zone and application of said zone to 6 properties

No submissions were received from the public in attendance.
