The Village of Fruitvale is seeking an enthusiastic, energetic and self-motivated student to fill the temporary position of **SUMMER STUDENT LABOURER**. The posting is expected to start mid-June and will be terminated after 8 weeks have been completed.

Reporting directly to the Public Works Foreman, the successful candidates will be required to perform special assignment duties, including, but not limited to, working with the Communities in Bloom organization to assist with the downtown beautification strategy, cemetery grounds maintenance and decorative brick realignment in the downtown core. Assignments are performed under general supervision and performance is subject to review, inspection and evaluation by the Public Works Foreman.

As defined, a summer student employee shall be a high school graduate or a college/university student who is currently registered or has declared their intention to attend a bona fide college or university and who seeks employment. Student employees will be entitled to statutory benefits only and will not accumulate seniority. The wage will be \$15.00/hr based on a 40 hour week.
